Children are the future of the nation, society and family. Foundation of this future is laid in present, and the responsibility of this lies wholly with the mother-father, teacher, education and the environment. Development of personality is not possible without understanding the elements that work in the personality development of the children. Development of children's abilities through family environment, opportunities to fine talent, encouraging behaviour habits and company are the factors, which can work together to give children's development a new direction. But the condition is that the parents (mother-father) must be aware of all these elements or the future of the children will be jeopardized.

Mother and father play a potter's role in the personality development of the children. Initially, mother-fathers are fully responsible.
